Dr. da Costa is a Research Assistant Professor in the department of Nutrition at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Dr. da Costa received her BA in Biochemistry at Brandeis University, and her PhD in Pathology at Boston University School of Medicine.

She is a nutritional biochemist whose research interests include choline as it is related to human health and the importance of folate in choline metabolism. Specifically, she studies how changes in choline-related genes affect the dietary requirement of choline in humans. Dr. da Costa also manages the choline analyses of foods for the USDA database.
